Congratulations to our volleyball team! We have the privilege and excitement of planning our state trip to Cedar Rapids on November 2-5. Students and parents, we encourage you to support our volleyball team by traveling to Cedar Rapids.

1. School Schedule:

- Monday – 1:30 dismissal/Parent Teacher Conferences 4-8 p.m.
- Tuesday – No School
- Tuesday Win = No School Wednesday
- Tuesday Loss = Full Day of School Wednesday
- Wednesday Win = No School Thursday
- Wednesday Loss = Full Day of School Thursday
- No School on Friday

2. Volleyball Schedule at the Alliant Energy Powerhouse in Cedar Rapids:

- Tuesday, Nov. 3 at 10:00 a.m. vs. Davenport Assumption on Court 1
- Wednesday, Nov. 4 at 3:00 p.m. – Semi-Finals on Court 1
- Thursday, Nov. 5 at 3:00 p.m. – 3A Finals on Center Court

3. We encourage fans to purchase tickets online to limit lines at the Alliant Energy Powerhouse box office. Tickets can be purchased through <http://ticketmaster.com/> or charge by phone at 1-800-745-3000 for \$12 inclusive of all online fees. Tickets go on sale Tuesday, October 27 at 10:00 a.m. Admission will be charged for those kindergarten age and older. Tickets purchased in-person at the Alliant Energy Powerhouse box office are \$10.

4. Face Coverings are required when transitioning throughout the Alliant Energy Powerhouse. Face Coverings may be removed when once seated in non-student sections. Students sitting in designated student sections are required to wear face coverings at all times, even when seated, as they will NOT be subject to the same social distancing requirements as other spectators.

5. Spectators are asked to arrive no earlier than 30 minutes prior to the posted start time of the match they plan to attend. The visiting team will use the bench on the south side.

6. Capacity will be limited to 2,500 patrons per match session. If maximum capacity is reached, spectators will not be allowed to enter the arena. We strongly encourage fans to exit the arena following their team's match to allow space for incoming fans for the next matches.

7. **Fans will NOT be allowed to greet their teams** in the Main/Lobby Ticket Window area at the SW corner of the Alliant Energy Powerhouse following matches as they have done previously. Team/fan gatherings must occur offsite.

8. **There will be a “no re-entry” policy** for Alliant Energy Powerhouse to help manage social distancing behavior and spectator traffic flow. Pass outs will not be allowed. Spectators will need to purchase a ticket if they leave the arena and wish to return the same day.

9. Only clear bags smaller than 12x12x6 may be brought into the Alliant Energy Powerhouse. **Non-clear bags (purses, backpacks, ect.) will not be permitted.**

10. **These messages from the Iowa Girls High School Athletic Union:**

Balloons, banners, signs, light or laser pens, or any paper debris (including confetti) are strictly prohibited. Objects that provide a safety concern (pom-poms on sticks, etc.) are prohibited. Artificial noisemakers such as air horns, megaphones, cowbells, thunder sticks, etc. are not allowed. Alliant Energy Powerhouse Center policy prohibits pounding on seats. All spectators must wear a shirt and shoes during IGHSAU sponsored tournament matches. Shirts must be worn in a proper manner and shall not promote obscene or inappropriate content.

11. **Behavior:**

- We **STRONGLY** discourage students from staying in Cedar Rapids without adult supervision. Please have someone responsible for them to keep them accountable in representing their Lord and their school appropriately.
- Cheer for our team, not against the other team or crowd. **DO NOT DRAW ATTENTION TO YOURSELF AS A FAN.**
- Remember that all school rules apply during our time in Cedar Rapids.
- Remember that you carry the name of Christ with you in every hotel, restaurant and store you enter.

12. **Students are expected to plan arrangements for transportation** and lodging with their family or families of friends. **There will NOT be a fan bus this year.**

13. **If you ordered a state T-shirt**, they will be here on noon on Monday.
