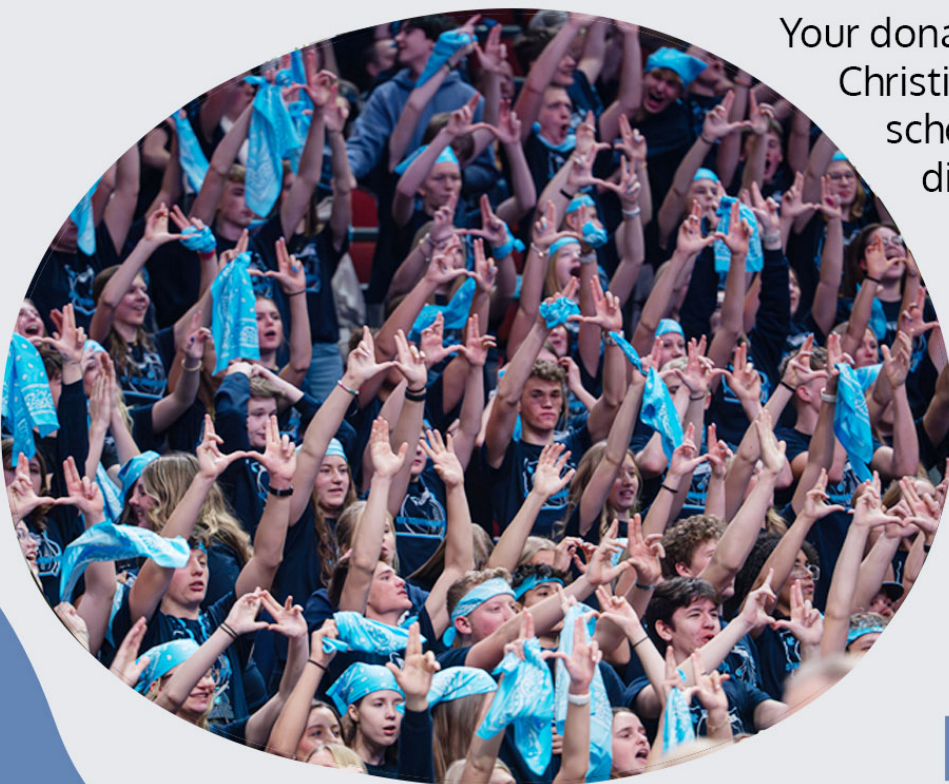
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NICSTO

NICSTO is a program designed by Iowa state law to promote school choice for the benefit of Iowa students. The program distributes funds in the form of grants annually to low or moderate-income families attending schools within the organization. Unity Christian has the opportunity to raise funds to distribute to families in need of assistance. Even with the ESA program in place, there still is significant need for NICSTO funds.

Here is how NICSTO works:

If you have an Iowa income tax liability, you could give a donation to NICSTO which would then provide Unity Christian with funds to be used for tuition assistance. Then when your tax work is done, you will receive a tax-credit of 75% of your donation from the state of Iowa. **There is no limit on how much you can give!** You may donate by check, gifts of grain, stocks and bonds, or by donating your minimum distribution from an IRA.



Your donation directly benefits Unity Christian families. In the 2025-2026 school year we were able to distribute **\$236,379 to 91 families** in need of tuition assistance.
